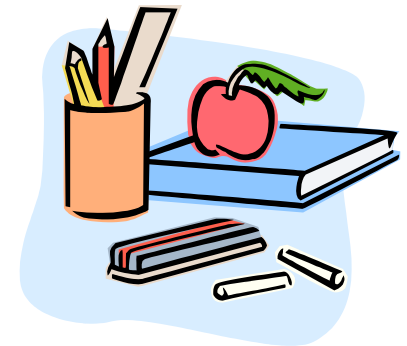

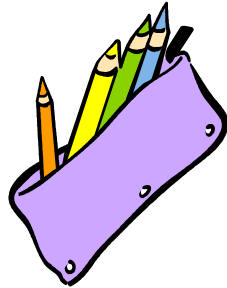


What you need

Binders (5)

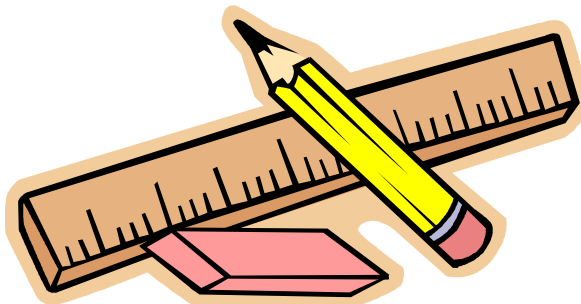


- 1) Blue for Social Studies 1"
 - 2) Green for Science 1"
 - 3) Red for Math 1½"
 - 4) White for English 1½"
 - 5) Black for Reading 1½"
- Notebook paper for binders
 - Spiral bound notebook (single subject, 3 hole punch)
 - Paper reinforcements
 - Three hole punch (fits in binder)
 - Two-pocket folder
 - Post-its 3" x 3" (stickies)
 - Index cards (4x6) one pack with lines
 - Paperback novel for pleasure reading



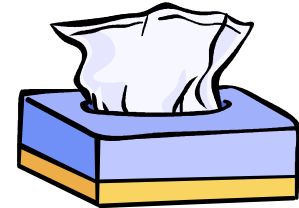
- Pencil case
