ASSIGNMENT: Choose one book that you really liked and design a book jacket following the template that is attached. Include a summary, a book review, illustrations, and information about the author...and have fun!

Bring the reading log and your book jacket project back to school on August 31st—the first day of school of the 2010-2011 school year. We will recognize students who participate in the summer reading program and submit logs.
