Elementary Enrichment Center

North Beverly is proud to host the district-wide Elementary Enrichment Center (EEC) program. The EEC is designed to meet the needs of academically talented students who benefit from working with peers of like ability. The program identifies students who have exhibited an interaction among three basic clusters of human traits: above average abilities, high levels of task commitment, and high levels of creativity.

The EEC is a full-day, pull-out program offering differentiated instruction with a focus on higher, more abstract, levels of thinking. Identified students from grades 3, 4, and 5 throughout the city attend a on a one-day per week basis.

About North Beverly Elementary



Nestled in a quiet North Beverly neighborhood and surrounded by the scenic woods of Norwood Pond, North Beverly is most easily located by the large red and white-checked water tank, which towers over our school. The school is located on a side street off Brimbal Avenue, about half way between the North Shore Music Theatre and North Beverly Railroad Crossing.

The Facility

The school, which was originally built in 1956, was recently rededicated in September 2002, following a significant renovation and addition project. Without question, it is a beautiful state-of-the-art facility!

North Beverly includes a media center with an adjacent computer lab, the hub of its students' research projects and activities. The integration of technology across content areas is something North Beverly is proud to offer its students.

We have nineteen classrooms, each equipped with computer access, and a new gymnasium with six basketball hoops.

In addition, there is dedicated space for art, music, guidance, reading, math, speech and language services, occupational and physical therapies, and learning support programs.

North Beverly Features

- Curriculum and staff development following the guidelines of the Massachusetts State Curriculum Frameworks, with a strong emphasis on implementing **research-based curriculum** in Language Arts and Mathematics.
- **Reading Support** is available in and out of the classroom and Title One Math support is available in and out of the classroom.
- **Support services** in developmental reading and mathematics including a daily, uninterrupted 90-minute literacy block, following a 3-tiered model of reading intervention for all students and a daily, uninterrupted 60-minute math block for all students.
- A beautiful **library** and **computer lab/media center** and dedicated classrooms for art, music and science.
- Over **ninety networked computers** in the building.



- **Specialized classrooms** that provide instruction to children with specific learning needs such as developmental delays and those requiring strategies based instruction.
- An **inclusionary / resource room** combination model for students with special learning needs.
- **Certified professionals** in the areas of speech therapy, physical therapy, occupational therapy, learning disabilities and counseling services and a **full-time registered nurse** with examining room, recovery room and office.

- Efforts to **integrate the arts** across the curriculum at all grade levels.
- Weekly **instrumental and string lessons** offered on site to students in grades four and five.
- Implementation of the pro-social curriculum, **Second Step**, which addresses character and citizenship responsibility.
- On site **after school care** offered by the YMCA.



- An **outside play area** with a fenced-in play yard and basketball courts. We also have large grass fields that can be used for kickball, soccer and other team sports.
- **A strong and active PTO** brings enrichment programs to our school, supports classroom instruction and provides the "extras" that help students and teachers to be successful.
- The **School Council** actively engages in advancing student learning, focusing on such issues as providing additional support to our most at-risk learners and enhancing professional development for teachers and staff.
