How it Works:

- Interested Community Members (parents, family members, Beverly administrators, Rotarians, local business partners, etc.) volunteer to run Student Enrichment Clubs; volunteers can elect to run a club for one session, two sessions or all three sessions; child care will be offered through our “Child Care Club” for volunteers with small children; volunteers are welcomed to partner with other volunteers to co-run a club
- Students (along with assistance from their families) indicate their top 3 choices of clubs from a preset list of options
- Teachers collaborate to place every student into a club of their choosing before the start of each session (there will be limited spots in each club – about 15

- students in each club, but we will try to place students in one of their top 3 choices)
- Community Volunteers plan and facilitate activities for each *Stars Club* day throughout a given session
  - There will be opportunities for volunteers to serve as program “coordinators” in lieu of running their own clubs
  - All community volunteers will participate in a *Stars Club* orientation
