Who's eligible?

Students must be aged 15 to 18 ½ at time of departure. Most students choose to go during their junior year
or for the year following their high school graduation. Students should be of above average academic
standing (top third). Candidates should be outgoing and adventuresome,
flexible and open to living in a different culture.
