

### **Elementary Program and Assessment (Grades 1-5)**

Students will read one or more books from the summer reading list. Students will keep a reading log that can be passed in to their teacher in September. Students will be recognized for their summer reading through each individual school's promotional reading program.

The Beverly Public School librarians and the Beverly Public Library staff have collaborated in producing a list of recommended reading for elementary students that is available on the library website: [www.noblenet.org/beverly](http://www.noblenet.org/beverly). The theme this year is "Catch the Beat" @Your Library. Click on kidlink and then readingzone.

In the spring the Beverly Public Librarians will visit the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> grade classes to discuss book selections from the Summer Reading list. They will disseminate information regarding the website. Grade 5 students will receive their information when visits are made from the Briscoe Middle School administration in the spring.

Classroom teachers will distribute reading logs to their students in June and explain the procedure for returning them in the fall. Students who participate in the Beverly Public Library summer events will receive certificates of participation from the Librarians at the Public Library when they return to school in the fall.
